Wessex Stationary Engine Club Ltd - Safety Rules

The committee hopes that you have a happy and interesting year and ask that you comply with these common sense rules whilst exhibiting your engine.

1. All engines and driven machinery must be exhibited within a barriered enclosure. They must be a minimum of 1.8 metres from the safety barrier and at least 1 metre apart.
2. No member of the public is allowed on the exhibit side of the barrier on any pretext whatsoever.
3. Engines must be displayed so as to have their flywheels parallel to the barrier and where possible, furthest away from the onlooker.
4. No machine may be worked on, cleaned, polished or refuelled whilst running.
5. The area around the exhibit must be kept clear of trip hazards and drawbars must be stowed as safely as may be practicable.
6. **No engine shall be left unattended. Any person delegated to oversee its operation in the temporary absence of the exhibitor, must be competent and have sufficient knowledge and experience to stop the machine in an emergency.**
7. As far as is practicable, engines and driven machinery must be 'good neighbours'. Reasonable levels of exhaust cleanliness and silencing are expected.
8. Any exhibitor failing to comply with these basic guidelines may be asked to shut down their engine and/or driven machinery. Reasonable warning may be given.
